Demonstration of TEES dissection & hands on dissection (bilateral)

Cadaveric dissection

- Trim hairs
- Meatal incision placement
- Meatal skin flap
- Elevation of squamous layer of TM
- Interposition graft
- Elevation of fibrous layer
- Inspect middle ear & Anatomical review
- Underlay graft
- Harvest tragal grafts
- Removal of incus
- Cartilage myringostapediopexy
- Remove stapes superstructure (laser or drill)
- TORP
- Atticotomy (curettage)
- Remove malleus head
- Inspect attic and anatomical review
- Scutum reconstruction
- Atticoantrostomy & canalplasty (curettage then drill)
